


Doors close to corners

This type of door should always be fitted with a corner ramp.



Centrally placed doors


At a centrally placed door, corner ramps are essential.





Hallways with many doors

In many homes, hallways give access to all other rooms. In this case, access can be improved greatly if the complete floor is lifted. The floor may be covered with carpets to hide that it is lifted. Due to the tiles and carpets this type of floor is quite comfortable to move on with wheels.



Deep-set doors

When installing ramps in deep-set doors it is important to build it very close to the door frame/wall, so a walker cannot get "caught" in the gap.
